OBJECTIVES: Students enrolled in AP Music Theory will learn aspects of music associated with the AP Music Theory exam including singing music by sight, writing music by ear (dictation), formal analysis, and composition.

MATERIALS: Students should bring the following to class:
- Pencil & standard notebook or another electronic notetaking device.
- Blank music manuscript paper (12 lines recommended).
- 3 ring binder recommended to organize paper lecture notes.

EXTRA HELP

The final grade is based on the following three areas:

- 1) **Assignments:** This includes any in-class work whether individually or in a group, and daily homework. (35% of the final grade)
- 2) **Projects:** Students will have more substantial assignments/projects each quarter. (25% of the final grade)
- 3) **Tests:** Students will be tested on their knowledge taken from class lectures and daily assignments, including performance tests in singing and dictation. (40% of the final grade)
