OBJECTIVES

Membership in the CCHS Orchestras presents an opportunity for developing string players to study and perform on their instruments, focusing on developing musicianship and technique. Each student is expected to study and experience orchestra music. Emphasis is placed on improving individual skills, appropriate personal practice, and understanding responsibilities to the ensemble.

EXPECTATIONS AND MATERIALS

Members of this class are expected to:

- Have a clean, working instrument each day
- Have all accessories needed to play (rosin, shoulder rest, etc.) and a pencil
- Have a metronome and tuner (there are great apps for smartphones including Tonal Energy)
- Spend at least 2 hours/week practicing their instrument
- Attend all festivals, concerts, and any extra rehearsals necessary to prepare for these events

REQUIRED FEES

- \$65 Instrumental Music Participation Fee
 - **You must pay this in person at the main office.** This fee is charged by the school/district and only needs to be paid once regardless of how many instrumental music classes you take.
- \$30 Class Fee
 - **Must be paid online.** This is a fee that helps pay for music, concerts, parties, clinicians, and other class experiences. (This will not show up online for a couple weeks.)
- \$80 Instrument Rental Fee (if renting a school owned instrument)
 - **Must be paid online.** Only required if using a school-owned instrument; allows you to use the instrument all year. You still pay maintenance costs and damage. Only pay this once if using the same instrument in multiple classes.

ATTENDANCE

Students will be given points for daily participation and attendance. If a student is absent, equivalent course work must be done to make up the participation points. Students must be in the orchestra room assembling their instruments when the bell rings and must be in their seats ready to play 3 minutes after the bell rings to avoid being marked tardy. Attendance at additional rehearsals, concerts, festivals, and other performances are mandatory and do not make up missed classes during the day.

If you will be gone from a class or rehearsal, please email me in advance. Active communication is an important part of being a musician in an ensemble.

EXTRA HELP

Students needing extra help can come in before school between 7:05 and 7:45 during Charger Time or meet after school by appointment. (I will be working with ensembles and individuals frequently, so schedule a time with me.) However, no extra credit will be offered, as per school-wide CCHS policy.

The final grade is based on the following three areas:

1) **Rehearsal Etiquette:** This includes the following: bringing instruments and materials to class, engaging in class activities, attending sectionals, any written homework or tests, and concert reports.

At times it is necessary to combine with other classes (percussion, strings, etc.) for concerts. The Rehearsal schedule will be posted in the orchestra room and updated regularly. Students are expected to attend these rehearsals. Students who do not attend at least 80% of extra rehearsals will not be able to perform at region and state and may lose concert performance privileges as well. Absences from these rehearsals must be excused at least 48 hours in advance. Special circumstances will be dealt with on an individual basis. (34% of the final grade)

2) **Performances:** Class members of the orchestras participate in concerts, clinics, sectionals, assemblies, and the school musical. In general, absences from performances will not be excused. However, in special situations approved by Dr. Clark, absences can be excused only if 2 week notice has been given—communicate with Dr. Clark early, about any conflicts.

Missing a performance can result in the loss of all performance credit for the quarter. Make-up for an excused absence from a performance can be accomplished by completing the “concert make-up assignment” as outlined on the makeup handout. Special circumstances will be dealt with on an individual basis. (33% of the final grade). Required performance attire is detailed on the CCHS Instrumental Music Website, cornercanyonmusic.weebly.com.

3) **Tests:** Playing tests will be assigned from class repertoire and other materials. Students must receive at least a B+ on playing tests involving festival music in order to perform in Region and State events. Students may retake these tests at any time before the event to be able to perform. Individual circumstances will be taken into consideration. (33% of the final grade)

OTHER DISCLOSURES

Cell phone policy: Students should not have a cell phone at their chair in class unless otherwise instructed, or prior permission is granted. They should be set to “do not disturb” for the duration of every rehearsal. Students found in violation of this policy, without prior approval, may receive a reduction in “Rehearsal Etiquette” credit. At times, and with permission, devices might be used as a tuner or a metronome.

Late work: Late work will only be accepted for credit up until the end of the unit. Once the unit has finished, it will no longer be possible to make up that work.

Make-up opportunities: There will be no NG’s given this year. If a student needs to raise their grade, there will be make-up opportunities available. Please email Dr. Clark or schedule an appointment to take advantage of make-up work. randal.clark@canyonsdistrict.org

Media Release: Classes may be recorded. Students may be visible or audible in these recordings. Recordings will only be available on Canvas for absent students. These will remain in a closed network and will not be shared elsewhere. Signing this disclosure grants permission to be in these recordings. You may also opt out (see signature page).

Hall Pass: With approval, students may use the hall pass to briefly excuse themselves for personal needs.

Remind: We use Remind to send messages to students/parents. These can be crucial alerts, including calendar changes. Remind is a free service that lets me send quick messages via text, push notifications, or email to everyone involved with the class. We'll be able to stay in touch without revealing our personal contact information.

- Step 2 Once you've downloaded the app, create a parent account with your email address.
